

Orchestra Sectional Schedule – 2nd Semester

All orchestra students are required to attend sectionals. Sectionals are designed to further help in the understanding and mastery of the orchestra literature. Below, you will find your section's required dates for sectionals, which will take place afterschool (3:15pm – 3:55pm). If you have an afterschool activity, please notify your coach or sponsor in advance of your sectional. In the event that you miss a sectional and it was an excused absence, you may make it up on a make-up day listed below or turn in a practice log for the week of the missed absence along with a recording of yourself playing all the pieces on the upcoming concert. Examples of excused absences: school absence, early leave, emergency, or co-curricular activity leaving early on the bus for an event.
